Jeffco Schools Purple Turns Green

The color purple has long been a part of Jeffco's "look" and logo. But a new year brings a new greenish tint to Jeffco's signature color. The district is implementing a district-wide recycling program in its effort to be more environmentally friendly. Joe Pitoniak, Jeffco's director of custodial services said, "We are recycling virtually everything including paper, plastic and cans." In every area of the district the process will be single stream recycling; that's where the materials collected are all mixed together with no sorting required. Participating in the program is voluntary for schools but many are expected to take advantage of the easy process. "We believe it is money well-spent when we can point to recycling the waste that has been simply thrown away in the past," said Jeffco's Chief Operating Officer, Bob Smith.
